Christmas Tree Recycling

Your Christmas tree may be recycled at the City of San Clemente's tree recycling program or with CR&R beginning **December 26 through January 6.**

The HOA does not perform this function.

Follow these three simple steps to have your tree collected for recycling:

- Remove all ornaments, lights, and stands.
- Cut all trees over six feet tall in half.
- Place your tree bottom first and upright in your green waste container. If you cannot use the green waste container or do not have one, place your tree curbside on your trash service day (no earlier) and the tree collectors will come by in a separate truck; there is no need to call the office. Note: Flocked trees will be collected; however, they are not recyclable.

Daylight Saving Time

It is almost that time of year again. On the first Sunday in November, Daylight Saving Time is moved back to standard time — a sure sign that summer is over, and fall is here. So, remember to set your clocks back one hour before you go to sleep on Saturday, November 4.

Out of Town Guests Coming for the Holidays?

As a reminder, no vehicles may be parked on the TMC property streets between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. (early morning hours) seven days a week without a safelist. Parking is enforced in Talega by Patrol One. You can contact them directly at (949) 367-8055 or **www.patrol-one.com** to safelist a vehicle for up to 14 nights within a 30-day period.

- You must create a safelisting profile at www.patrol-one.com for your address to receive a temporary safelist for yourself or visitor/guest. Their license plate will act as their permit to park overnight after they receive their safelist confirmation number (and only for the dates selected).
- You must have an Activation Code in order to create your profile. These codes were mailed out in December 2019. If you don't know your code, contact info@talegatoday.com.

Be sure to place the confirmation number on the windshield from the inside of the vehicle.

If you live in a sub-association, contact your own management company to find out their particular parking rules and parking patrol vendor. Those communities would be: Carmel, Trinidad, Gallery, Verano, and Talega Village (Alassio/Santalana).

TMC 2023 Board Election Slate of Candidates

The Talega Maintenance Corporation (TMC) Election will be held on Tuesday, November 14, 2023, to elect two (2) members to the TMC Board of Directors for a three- (3) year term. The Board of Director's is comprised of representatives elected by the membership (homeowners). The Board of Director's role is to supervise the properties of the corporation, approve and oversee budgets, and make decisions which strive for the betterment of the corporation in accordance with the legal documents.

How Does the TMC Election Process Work?

A neighborhood delegate system was set in place to assist in achieving quorum for the election. The requirement for quorum is 25% of the voting power of the corporation. State law requires a ballot with a two-envelope system. It is important for members to complete and mail in their ballot in the envelopes provided. The votes will be counted immediately following the Annual Meeting/Election on Tuesday, November 14, 2023. An election notice and ballot will be sent to all homeowners in advance of the Annual Meeting. We strongly encourage your active participation in this election.


