2025 – 2026 Fiscal Year Budgeted Expenditures

Talega's 2025-2026 fiscal year has begun

For 25 years, TALEGA has cultivated a premier community that blends welcoming amenities, high-quality services, and recreational experiences. The volunteer Boards and Committees are committed to guiding TALEGA in a manner that protects the Corporation's value, relevance, and viability.

As a Master Homeowners Association, Talega Maintenance Corporation (Talega) is classified as a not for profit public benefit corporation, that is operated according to the Governing Documents (Articles of Incorporation, CC&Rs, bylaws, and policies and rules adopted by the Board of Directors). These documents create legal duties and obligations for the Association's members to preserve the value, desirability, and attractiveness of the property TALEGA owns and has a responsibility to maintain. To meet these duties and obligations, the Board adopts an annual budget with expenses that are determined in large measure as non-discretionary costs.

Annually, the Budget and Finance Committee, under the direction of the Board provides input and guidance into the preparation of the upcoming year's budget.

With the guidance and oversight of the Board of Directors, the Budget and Finance Committee builds the annual budget to address the costs associated with managing TALEGA'S anticipated expenses, insurance requirements, high-quality services, and long-term success. These factors shape the annual assessment rate.

The Board, Management and Staff have been successful in reducing the overall management costs and maintain existing service levels, accommodate the rise in non-discretionary costs, avoid the potential burden of large increases, and protect the Corporation's financial health. Therefore, the Board has determined that the assessment rate for the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year will remain at \$267 per month.

The following sectors make up the annual Talega Maintenance Corporation Operating Budget:


LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE TALEGA'S

largest asset is its landscape footprint, which requires careful maintenance as it ages in a worsening drought climate. In addition, the landscape industry battles labor shortages that impact wage and contract rates. Operational Expenses to maintain and replace the 700+ acres of ornamental landscape. This makes up approximately 28% of the annual operating budget or \$77 per home per month.

WATER & UTILITY RATES As California's drought increases in severity, water service providers are raising rates, implementing restrictions, and cutting back on rebate programs. TALEGA's budget reflects the projected expenditures for TALEGA's current irrigation infrastructure. Operational Expenses for electricity to power the street lights and water to irrigate the landscape within Talega's 1,800 acre footprint. This makes up approximately11% of the annual operating budget or \$29 per home per month.

ADMIN & MISC EXPENSES Expenses that cover a broad range of operational expenses ranging from Management Company fees, Employee Salaries, Legal Expenses and Insurances, make up approximately 20% of the annual operating budget or \$53 per home per month. Maintaining appropriate insurance coverage for the Corporation is imperative. Since mid-2022, the insurance market has experienced never-before-seen premium increases for both package and umbrella policies. TALEGA has budgeted additional funding for insurance coverage in the 2025-2026 fiscal year. Rising minimum wage tiers and the residual effects of COVID-19 continue to affect the availability and output of the workforce – not just at TALEGA, but nation-wide. As TALEGA's service providers adjust to these impacts, many vendors must increase contract rates in order to continue providing services.

RESERVE FUNDS A critical component of TALEGA's management is reserve funding. This savings program sets aside funds to replace or enhance various assets throughout the Corporation, from parking lots to pool furniture and Streets, Sidewalks, Tot Lots, Pool Facilities, Street Lights, Irrigation systems, and mailboxes. Thanks



COMMON AREA Operational Expenses routine maintenance of the tot lots, sidewalks, signage, etc., makes up approximately 10% of the annual operating budget or \$28 per home per month.


RECREATIONAL FACILITIES Operational

Expenses to operate and maintain the Talega Swim & Athletic Club, Saluda Recreation Pool and Tierra Grande Recreation Pool. These make up approximately 7% of the annual operating budget or \$18 per home per month.

LOOKING FORWARD

The Board's fiduciary responsibility to the Corporation requires realistic examination of assessment levels each year. Annual evaluation of assessments ensures that TALEGA protects its assets now and in the future. The Board of Directors is committed to fulfilling TALEGA's purpose without compromising the quality of life that makes TALEGA a premier community. Items of note are continued annual contributions to the Reserve Study to help repair and replace aging amenities within the community to ensure enjoyment by the members.

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TMC: Maintaining Infrastructure & Community Assets

The Talega Maintenance Corporation (TMC) functions as the master homeowners association (HOA) for the community. Its primary responsibility is the upkeep of common areas and facilities, ensuring that Talega remains clean, functional, and visually appealing.

How is TMC Funded?

TMC is funded through monthly HOA dues that every homeowner pays. As of April 1, 2025, the monthly HOA fee is \$267. If a homeowner resides in a gated neighborhood or sub-association, additional fees apply.

Where Does the Budget Go? TMC's funds are used for:

- Maintenance of Common Areas This includes landscaping, parks, walking trails, pools, playgrounds, and other shared spaces. The budget ensures that these areas remain safe and well-maintained.
- Operational Costs Funds cover property management, security, administrative expenses, and the day-to-day management of community services.
- Reserve Funds A portion of the HOA dues is set aside for long-term projects and major repairs, such as renovating pools or upgrading recreational facilities.

TMC is focused on preserving and improving the physical infrastructure of the community, ensuring Talega remains a desirable place to live.

TLC: Enhancing the Community Experience

While TMC maintains the physical aspects of the community, the Talega Lifestyle Corporation (TLC) is responsible for building the social and recreational environment within Talega. Established by the master developer, TLC was created to foster a sense of community by organizing events, programs, and resident-driven activities.

How is TLC Funded?

Unlike TMC, which relies on monthly dues, TLC is funded through a one-time "Lifestyle Fee" that is charged every time a home in Talega is resold. This fee is 1/4 of 1% of the home's sale price, paid at the close of escrow. These funds are exclusively dedicated to community-building initiatives.

Where Does the Budget Go?

TLC's funds are allocated to:

Lifestyle Events – Every year, TLC organizes events that bring residents together. These include:

- Talega's Tiki Luau A vibrant summer event featuring Hawaiian music, live performances, and island-themed entertainment.
- Harvest Oktoberfest A fall celebration with authentic German food, music, and festive games, creating a lively social atmosphere.
- Wine & Cheese A sophisticated gathering where residents can enjoy wine tastings, artisanal cheeses, and socializing with neighbors.
- Summer Concerts A community-favorite event where residents can enjoy live music in an outdoor setting, fostering a relaxed and enjoyable summer atmosphere.
- Programs & Clubs TLC provides funding for resident-driven recreational activities, fitness programs, and social clubs, based on community interests.
- Recreation & Technology TLC invests in community entertainment, event materials, and digital resources that enhance resident experiences.

E-bike riders have become a cause for concern due to irresponsible behavior on the streets and sidewalks. It is essential to report each instance of such activity to ensure the safety of all. Please utilize the non-emergency police line at (949) 770-6011 for reporting such incidents. In case of emergencies, do not hesitate to call 911. Additionally, the usage of Sur-Ron bikes



are prohibited on streets, sidewalks, and parks within the community. To ensure compliance with this regulation, law enforcement will take necessary

action. This measure is in place not only to prioritize pedestrian safety but also to preserve the quality and safety of our public spaces. Your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines and promptly reporting any violations is invaluable and aids in creating a community that prioritizes the safety and comfort of all residents. Together, we can foster an environment where everyone can enjoy the public spaces in our community with confidence and security.

Parking

As a reminder, no vehicles may be parked on the TMC property streets between the hours of 1:00AM and 6:00AM (early morning hours) seven days a week without a safelist. Parking is enforced in Talega by Patrol One. You can contact them directly at (949) 367-8055 or www.patrol-one.com to safelist a vehicle for up to 14 nights within a 30-day period.

- You must create a safelisting profile at www.patrol-one.com for your address to receive a temporary safelist for yourself or visitor/guest. Their license plate will act as their permit to park overnight after they receive their safelist confirmation number is received for the selected dates.
- You must have an activation code in order to create your profile. If you don't know your code, contact talega@ciramail.com.

Be sure to place the confirmation number on the windshield from the inside of the vehicle. If you live in a sub-association, contact your management company to find out the particular parking rules and parking patrol vendor specific to your association. Those communities are: Carmel, Trinidad, Gallery, Verano, and Talega Village (Alassio/Santalana).

If you require a safelist longer than 14 nights or you need an activation code, contact <u>Talega@ciramail.com</u>.

Pool Reminders

Make a Splash: Pool Rules & Safety Guidelines for a Fun-Filled Summer

As temperatures rise and pool season is in full swing, it's time to dive into summer fun! To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, please take a moment to review the important pool policies and guidelines below.

Guest Policy & Pool Usage

Each residence may bring up to five (5) guests per day to the pool facilities. While all pools are open for recreational use, lap pools are designated specifically for lap swimmers.

To respect their space, please avoid hanging on the lane lines or swimming across lanes while they are in use.

Flotation Devices & Water Toys

For safety purposes, only U.S. Coast Guard-approved life preservers (PFDII) are allowed. These life vests, marked as

"Coast Guard Approved," are available in various sizes and can be purchased at local sporting goods stores for around \$30.

Permitted water toys include:

- ✓ Inflatable beach balls
- ✓ Diving rings and similar pool toys
- ✓ Plastic masks and goggles
- ✓ Not Allowed: Foam noodles, pool floats, or large inflatables, as they can create safety risks and damage the pool's circulation system.

Pool Closures & Red Flag Alerts

Unexpected pool closures? Look for the red flag displayed outside the clubhouse to indicate when a pool is closed due to maintenance or unforeseen issues. For real-time updates, call (949) 361-8466.

Pool Monitors & Safety Breaks

Pool monitors will be on-site throughout the summer to promote a safe swimming environment and enforce Talega Maintenance Corporation (TMC) policies. However, pools operate under a

"Swim at Your Own Risk" policy, meaning parents must supervise their children at all times.

To keep our pools clean and accident-free, safety breaks will be observed every hour. These 10-minute breaks provide a great opportunity to hydrate, use the restroom, and reapply sunscreen. Only lap swimmers and swim lessons are exempt.

Additionally, for hygiene reasons, all young children must wear rubber swim pants over their swim diapers. These are available free of charge at the TSAC office or from a pool monitor.

Swim Lessons with Approved Instructors

Residents can take advantage of swim lessons provided by Talega-approved instructors at the Talega Clubhouse Pool. Lessons are not permitted at the Saluda or Tierra Grande Pools. A list of authorized instructors for 2024 will be

posted outside the pool gates.

If you notice unauthorized instructors, please report them to management at talega@ciramail.com or call (949) 361-8466.

Planning a Poolside Gathering?

Thinking about hosting a pool party? Gatherings are only permitted at the TSAC Clubhouse Pool and must be scheduled in advance. Events can take place Monday through Saturday, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with a maximum of 24 guests.




