Facility Amenities & How to Reserve Them



You may already be familiar with the various amenities available to Talega residents! Among these, certain amenities are available for advance reservation through Court Reserve. These include the Sport Court, Bocce Ball Court, and Volleyball Court at the Talega Swim & Athletic Clubhouse, as well as the Pickleball Court at Tierra Grande.

The first step to reserving a court is to create an account through the online reservation system called Court Reserve. If you are not yet set up on Court Reserve, please email Talega@ciaramail.com to get started!

All courts are open from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily and can be reserved for a maximum of 2 hours per day. Please note that equipment is not provided for the courts, with the exception of bocce ball, cornhole, and ping pong (see details below).

Remember to exercise courtesy when using the Court Reserve system. If you cannot make your court reservation, we ask that you please be mindful about canceling your reservation as soon as possible. This gesture will enable other residents to secure a reservation. To ensure that the court reservation system is being used appropriately, management will be conducting spot checks. Thank you in advance for your proactive courtesy.

 - Sports Court (featuring tennis, pickleball, and basketball courts), Bocce Ball Court, and Volleyball Court

Community Reminders

E-Bike Safety

E-bike riders have become a cause for concern due to irresponsible behavior on the streets and sidewalks. It is essential to report each instance of such activity to ensure the safety of all. Please utilize the non-emergency police line at (949) 770-6011 for reporting such incidents. In case of emergencies, do not hesitate to call 911. Additionally, the usage of Sur-Ron bikes are prohibited on streets, sidewalks, and parks within the community. To ensure compliance with this regulation, law enforcement will take necessary action. This measure is in place not only to prioritize pedestrian safety but also to preserve the quality and safety of our public spaces. Your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines and promptly reporting any violations is invaluable and aids in creating a community that prioritizes the safety and comfort of all residents. Together, we can foster an environment where everyone can enjoy the public spaces in our community with confidence and security.

Parking

As a reminder, no vehicles may be parked on the TMC property streets between the hours of 1:00AM and 6:00AM (early morning hours) seven days a week without a safelist. Parking is enforced in Talega by Patrol One. You can contact them directly at [\(949\) 367-8055](tel:9493678055) or www.patrol-one.com to safelist a vehicle for up to 14 nights within a 30-day period.

- You must create a safelisting profile at www.patrol-one.com for your address to receive a temporary safelist for yourself or visitor/guest. Their license plate will act as the permit to park overnight after the safelist confirmation number is received for the selected dates
- You must have an activation code in order to create your profile. If you don't know your code, contact Talega@ciramail.com.

Be sure to place the confirmation number on the windshield from the inside of the vehicle. If you live in a sub-association, contact your management company to find out the particular parking rules and parking patrol vendor specific to your association. Those communities are: Carmel, Trinidad, Gallery, Verano, and Talega Village (Alassio/Santalana).

If you require a safelist longer than 14 nights or you need an activation code, contact Talega@ciramail.com.

Reminder Assessment Payment Responsibility

Dear Members,

Reminder, it is each TMC Member's individual responsibility to ensure that assessments are paid in full and on time, and to verify that all payments, whether made by ACH (automated clearing house), online banking, mailed check, or other method, are properly processed.

TMC and its management team are not responsible for monitoring individual Member accounts or generally confirming receipt of payments on behalf of any Member.

To avoid late fees, interest, or further collection action, we encourage you to:

- Review your TMC statements monthly;
- Confirm that your ACH or online payment method is properly configured and active;
- Ensure that sufficient funds are available in your payment account;
- Regularly check your Association account balance and payment status; and
- Immediately contact management if you suspect a payment issue.

As a reminder, late, partial, or missed payments are subject to late charges, interest, legal fees, and possible further collection efforts. If notices are ignored further collection activities may include a lawsuit and/or lien and eventual foreclosure of your home.

Streamline your payments by enrolling in ACH automatic bill payment through the [GrandManors Resident Portal](#). Please make sure you login to the resident portal under the "for residents" tab on [Talegatoday.com](#).

Once set up, your payment will be automatically drawn from your bank account on the 2nd or 3rd of the month and posted to your account by the 5th or 6th, depending on holidays or weekends. This stress-free option saves you time and ensures you never miss a deadline.

Fast and Flexible Online Payments

Need flexibility? Use the GrandManors Resident Portal to make a one-time payment with your bank account or credit card. Credit card payments are subject to a small processing fee, but both methods are quick and easy. Payments typically post to your account within 72 hours, depending on weekends and holidays..

Bank Bill Pay Made Easy

If you're already using your bank's bill payment system, you can add Talega Maintenance Corporation to your list of payees. This is a reliable method that can take 10–14 business days to post to your account based on your bank's processing times. Plan ahead to make sure your payment reaches on time!

Mail-In Option

Prefer the classic touch? You can always write a paper check and mail it to the following address listed on your statement. This option works well however, it's important to allow up to 14 business days for your payment to post to your account. Be sure to mail your check early to avoid any posting delays!

Make sure you are checking the Resident Portal periodically for information about upcoming payments.

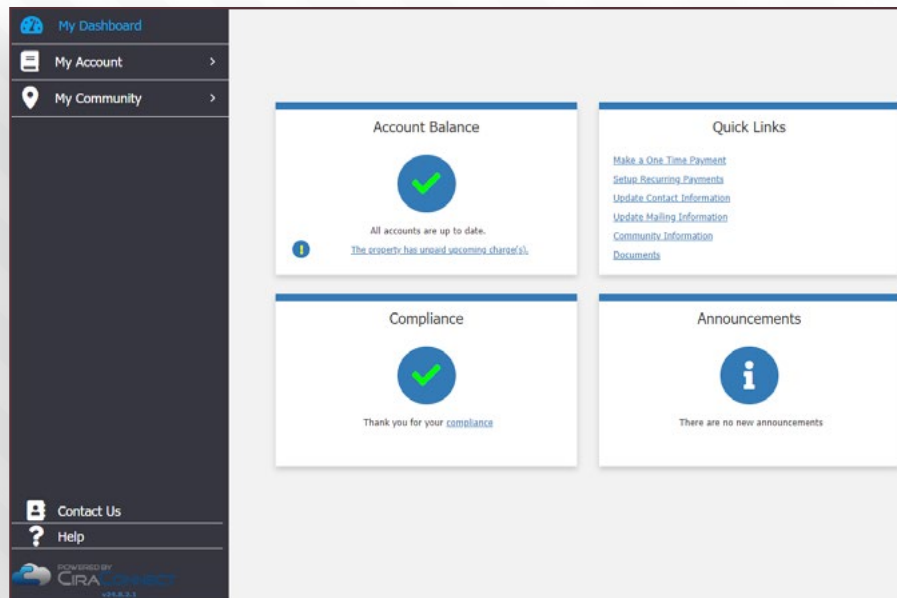
Payments are due on the 1st of every month, to avoid late fees your payment must post to your account by the 15th of each month.

Talega Community Moves Toward a Chemical-Free Future:

Vinegar Replaces Herbicides for Hardscape Weed Control

San Clemente, CA — In a significant step toward more sustainable landscape practices, the Talega community has officially launched its new partnership with Artistic Maintenance, Inc., a vendor selected through a comprehensive review process led by Mosaic Consulting and supported by the TMC management team, the Board, and a dedicated feasibility committee. Among the most notable changes in the new approach: the use of vinegar as a natural alternative to chemical herbicides for managing hardscape weeds.

This shift is part of a broader commitment by the Talega community to reduce chemical usage in its landscape maintenance. “No one wanted to use chemicals unnecessarily,” said Devin Sanders, Principal at Mosaic Consulting. “There were those who were concerned about costs and maintaining the aesthetics of the

rich landscape that Talega is known for. The key was redefining how we would maintain the landscape—focusing on soil health, preventative care, and reserving chemical use for only the most severe situations.”

Under the new strategy, vinegar—a simple, eco-friendly substance—will be used to control weeds in hardscape areas such as center medians, sidewalks, and pavers. This method not only aligns with the community’s environmental goals but also supports the health and safety of residents, pets, and local wildlife.

Artistic Maintenance, Inc. officially began service on May 1, 2025, bringing a philosophy rooted in working with nature, not against it. “The crews are trained to observe, adapt, and support the natural environment,” said a spokesperson from Artistic. “We’re not here to eliminate every leaf or blade of grass that grows out of place. We’re here

to maintain beauty in a way that’s healthier and more balanced—for people and the planet.”

The landscape management team emphasized that early detection, consistent monitoring, and a commitment to soil and plant health will serve as the foundation of Talega’s new approach. “There is now a structured process in place to evaluate any potential need for chemical intervention,” said Sanders. “But we’re confident that with our proactive practices, such instances will be rare.”

With this transition, Talega sets a powerful example of how communities can maintain vibrant, beautiful landscapes without compromising environmental integrity.

Pool Reminders

Make a Splash: Pool Rules & Safety Guidelines for a Fun-Filled Summer

As temperatures rise and pool season is in full swing, it's time to dive into summer fun! To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, please take a moment to review the important pool policies and guidelines below.

Guest Policy & Pool Usage

Each residence may bring up to five (5) guests per day to the pool facilities. While all pools are open for recreational use, lap pools are designated specifically for lap swimmers. To respect their space, please avoid hanging on the lane lines or swimming across lanes while they are in use.

Flotation Devices & Water Toys

For safety purposes, only U.S. Coast Guard-approved life preservers (PFDII) are allowed. These life vests, marked as "Coast Guard Approved," are available in various sizes and can be purchased at local sporting goods stores for around \$30.

Permitted water toys include:

- ✓ Inflatable beach balls
- ✓ Diving rings and similar pool toys
- ✓ Plastic masks and goggles
- ✗ Not Allowed:
 - Foam noodles
 - Pool floats
 - Large inflatables.

Pool Monitors & Safety Breaks

Pool monitors will be on-site throughout the summer to promote a safe swimming environment and enforce Talega Maintenance Corporation (TMC) policies. However, pools operate under a "Swim at Your Own Risk" policy, meaning parents must supervise their children at all times.

To keep our pools clean and accident-free, safety breaks will be observed every hour. These 10-minute breaks provide a great opportunity to hydrate, use the restroom, and reapply sunscreen. Only lap swimmers and swim lessons are exempt.

Additionally, for hygiene reasons, all young children must wear rubber swim pants over their swim diapers. These are available free of charge at the TSAC office or from a pool monitor.

Pool Closures & Red Flag Alerts

Unexpected pool closures? Look for the red flag displayed outside the clubhouse to indicate when a pool is closed due to maintenance or unforeseen issues. For real-time updates, call [\(949\) 361-8466](tel:949-361-8466).

Swim Lessons with Approved Instructors

Residents can take advantage of swim lessons provided by Talega-approved instructors at the Talega Clubhouse Pool. Lessons are not permitted at the Saluda or Tierra Grande

Pools. A list of authorized instructors for 2025 will be posted outside the pool gates.

Planning a Poolside Gathering?

Thinking about hosting a pool party? Gatherings are only permitted at the TSAC Clubhouse Pool and must be scheduled in advance. Events can take place Monday through Saturday, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with a maximum of 24 guests.

- Can be a positive voice for the community, relay perspectives on matters that are relevant to the membership, and solicit feedback when requested by TMC or its Board of Directors

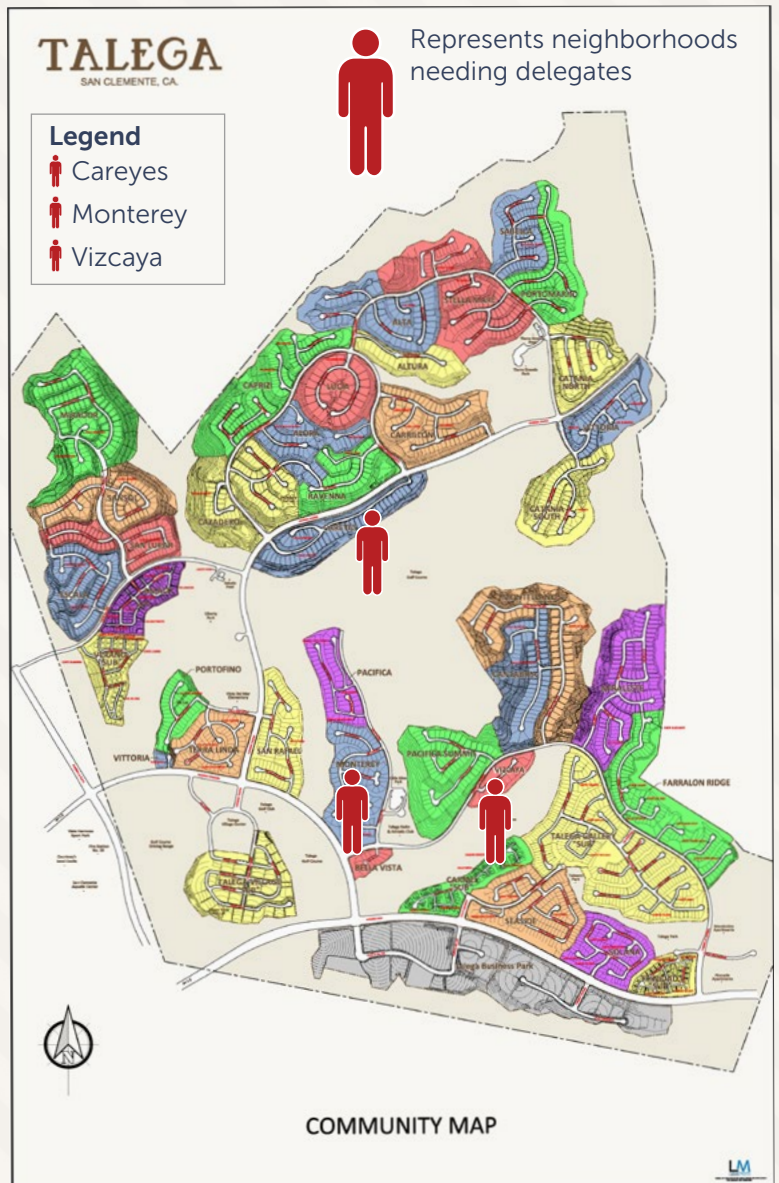

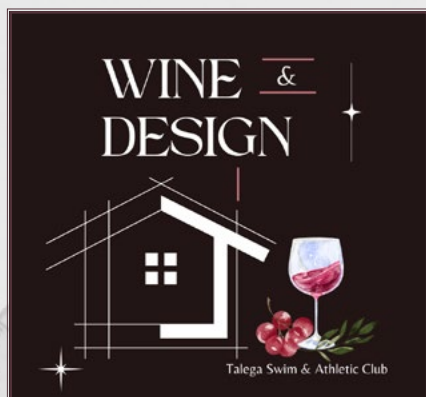

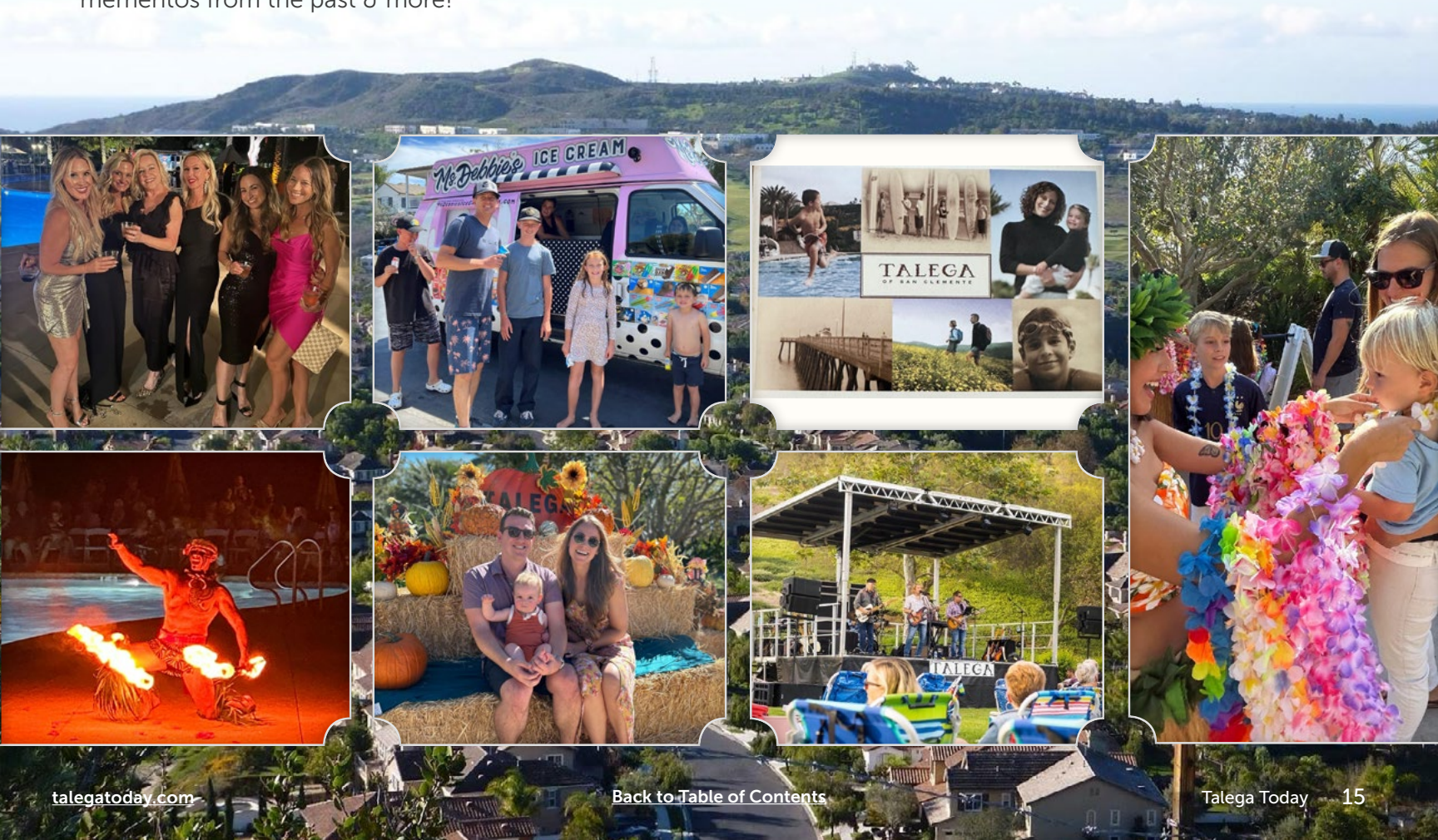

How to Register for Events

In 2025, event registrations will be online only, unless noted *otherwise*. Registration links will be available in weekly e-blasts and on talegatoday.com under the “**Events & Programs**” tab. TLC highly suggests subscribing to e-blasts because they are the best way to stay updated with event information.

Please review some key information about registering for events:

- Pre-registration is required for all events.*
- Registration typically goes live 4-5 weeks prior to the event at 10:00AM PST.**

- There is a two (2) adult maximum per household, per event.***

- Increasing headcounts after the event has sold out or on the same day is not permitted and will not be accommodated.
- The cancellation policy remains in effect for all events with and without registration charges.

EVENTS CANCELLATION POLICY

TLC understands that unforeseen circumstances may arise. We ask that those who can cancel in a timely manner please do so. Events are carefully planned and all registrants are accounted and paid for.

Failing to notify of cancellation in a timely manner compromises others. **Waitlists fill quickly, and management is unable to notify those on the waitlist the day before and the day of the event.** Help management help you and your neighbors.

The policy is as follows:

- Talega Lifestyle Events are for Talega residents only. Guests and family cannot be accommodated.
- Adult events are limited to two (2) adults per household. Additional adult(s) residing in the household require prior approval and verification of Talega residency 48 hours before registering for an event.
- All cancellations must be emailed to TalegaLC@ciramail.com.
- Cancellations received 14 days or more prior to the event (by 5:00PM on the 14th day) will receive a full refund.
- Cancellations received less than 14 days prior to the event or no-show will not be refunded.
- Cancellations received 48 hours prior to the event will be considered a violation. A notice reminding you of the cancellation policy will be sent to your residency.
- Registering and failing to attend will be considered a violation and will result in a charge equaling the actual unsubsidized cost of attendance per person.
- Upon your third offense, you may be denied registration for one or more future events.
- No balance or ticket transfers will be accommodated.

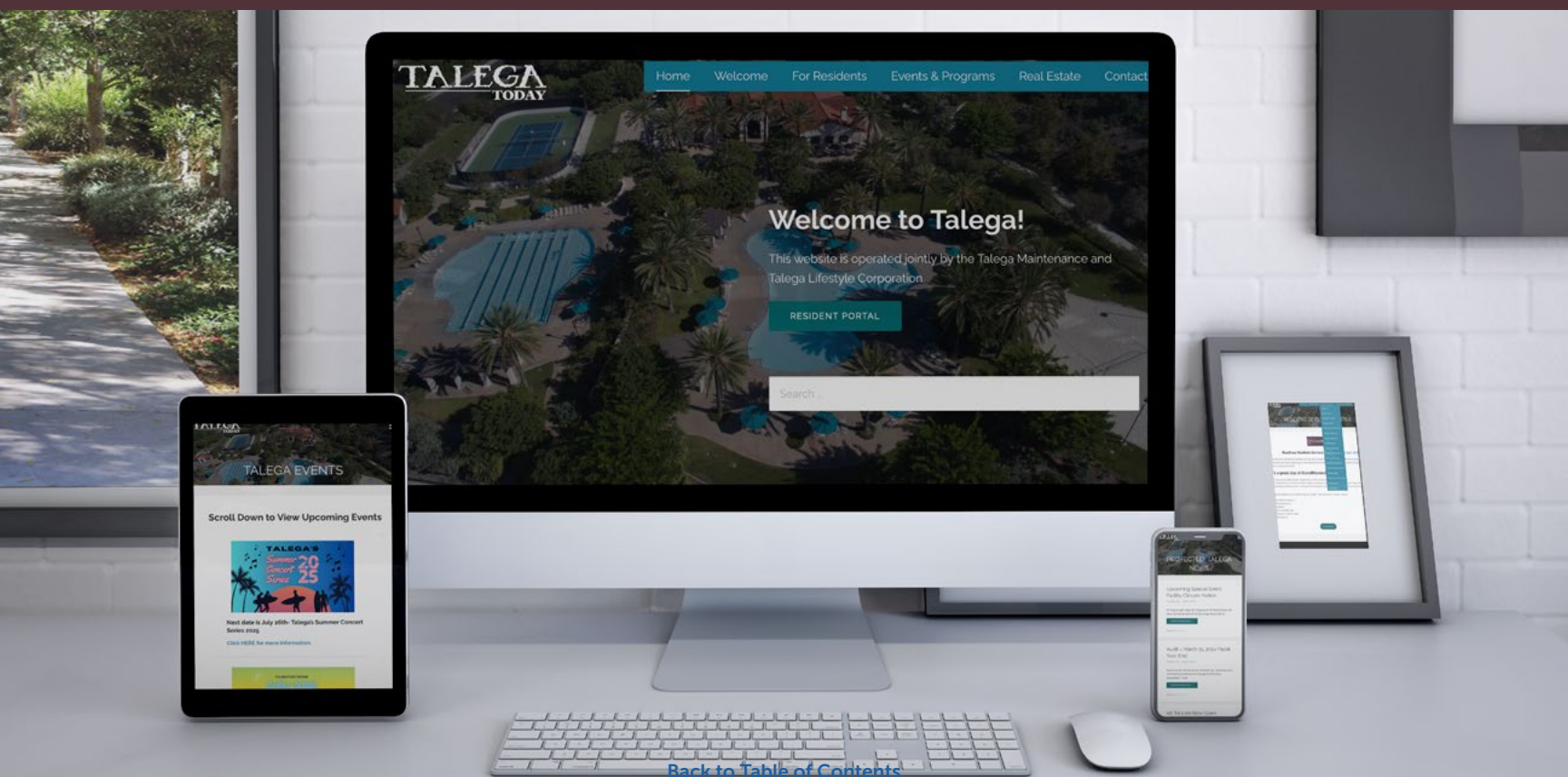
