

As the only woman serving on the Board, I bring a perspective that complements those of my fellow directors. I have served diligently on the Board for 16 years. As a “Talega mom” and business owner, I offer insights shaped by years of raising my family, running a business, and serving in a variety of volunteer roles throughout our community. I also bring decades of experience and a deep understanding of Talega that provide valuable continuity and historical perspective for the Board. I have helped lead meaningful improvements that enhance our quality of life while protecting long-term property values. These projects include adding the Tierra Grande pickleball court, the bocce ball court at the Talega Swim & Athletic Club, redesigning all pool restrooms, and overseeing the upgraded splash and play area. I am also currently leading the redesign of the clubhouse and working to add new amenities, including restrooms, at Altea Park. Beyond community amenities, I have focused on initiatives that strengthen and protect Talega. I helped navigate a complex lawsuit with the builder to preserve our safe and accessible hiking trail system. I have advocated for reducing pesticide use by over 90% throughout the community and helped pilot and implement license plate reader cameras, which have proven valuable in addressing crime and vandalism. Since joining the Board of Directors in 2010, I have provided continuity, institutional knowledge, and a long-term perspective on the needs of our community. My service to Talega spans more than 20 years. I served as a Talega Delegate from 2005 to 2006, then on the Enforcement Committee from 2007 to 2010. I have also served on the Mako Foundation at Vista Del Mar School and volunteered in a variety of roles supporting San Clemente High School athletics. As a longtime Talega homeowner who has owned two homes here and raised three children in this community, I understand the full lifecycle of living in Talega. I have built trust with homeowners over the past two decades, which has been one of the greatest privileges of my service. My goal has always been to preserve and enhance our community’s quality, value, and livability while ensuring Board decisions are made thoughtfully, transparently, and in the best interests of homeowners. I care deeply about Talega and would be honored to continue serving in a way that protects what makes this community special while planning responsibly for its future.
